conditions for attracting foreign investments and expanding the resource base for future socioeconomic development.

Promoting new lending with foreign capital will be the next challenge. It should support post-war recovery but will be impeded by huge security risks associated with Ukraine's geopolitical position and de facto limited access to credit. The revival of lending must closely follow the structure of Ukraine's post-war economy, and in the first stage, the provision of trade finance will be paramount.

The agrarian sphere is an important part of the Ukrainian economy, with agriculture playing a significant role in the country's overall GDP. Ukraine is known for its fertile soil and favorable climate, which make it well-suited for agricultural production. The country has a long history of farming and is considered one of the world's breadbaskets.

The Ukrainian agricultural sector has a significant production potential exceeds the needs of the domestic market, is a link that, on the one hand, can to become a locomotive for the development of the national economy and its efficiency integration into the global economic space, and on the other hand - income growth, of the rural population involved in the agrarian economy, which is more than a third of the entire population of the country, to give a multiplier effect in development other branches of the national economy [3].

A feature of the functioning of the organizational and legal mechanism of support development of the agricultural sector in Ukraine today is that, on the one hand, there is no full financial support for the adopted laws, and on the other hand, non-implementation of already adopted laws and other normative legal acts, i.e. low executive discipline in state bodies authorities [1].
