The comparability of statistical data on agro-industrial production in retrospect is correct because the State Statistics Service of Ukraine formed the main indicators of agriculture for 2010-2016 without taking into account the temporarily occupied territory of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol.

The agricultural sector for the Ukrainian state has always been one of the priority areas of both foreign economic and domestic economic development of the country, because the issues of organization of production and support of food supply for an individual state are relevant at all times. From it depends not only on the viability and self-sufficiency of the country and society, but also on many different areas of human activity.
